Mayo Clinic Express Care offers care for multiple common health concerns and vaccinations. Care is available for patients **18 months through 75 years old** unless otherwise noted.

SCHEDULE A VISIT

If you're already a Mayo Clinic patient, you can schedule a visit:

- By logging onto Patient Online Services mayoclinic.org/online-services
- Via the Mayo Clinic App
- At an on-site kiosk (select locations), however an appointment may not be immediately available
- By calling your primary care appointment office

Walk-in visits are available on a first-come, first-served basis (sign up on arrival).

The cost of your visit may be partially or completely covered by insurance, so be sure to check with your insurance provider. Lab and other services may add to the cost.

For Mayo Clinic patients, details of your visit will be included in your Mayo medical record.

Language interpreting is offered for non-English-speaking patients at no charge.
