## GETTING AROUND CAMPUS

### Escorts and wheelchairs

### SMOKE-FREE ENVIRONMENT

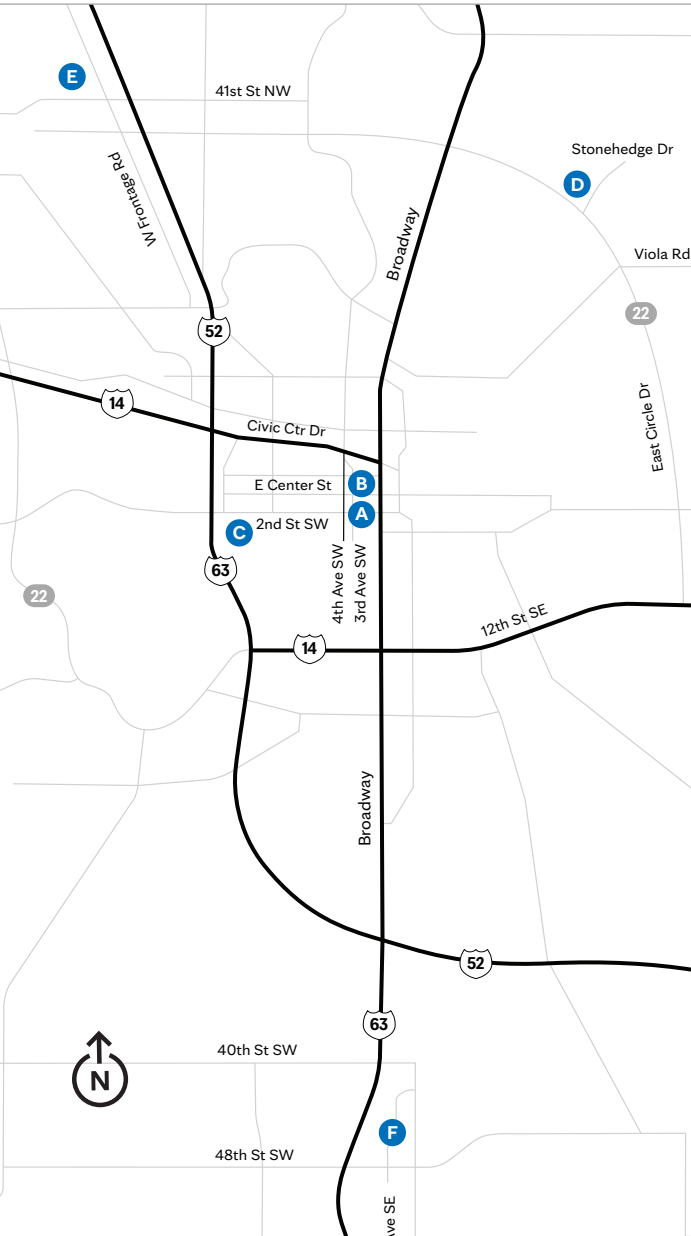
Mayo Clinic is a smoke-free institution. Smoking is not permitted in any Mayo facility or on clinic or hospital grounds.

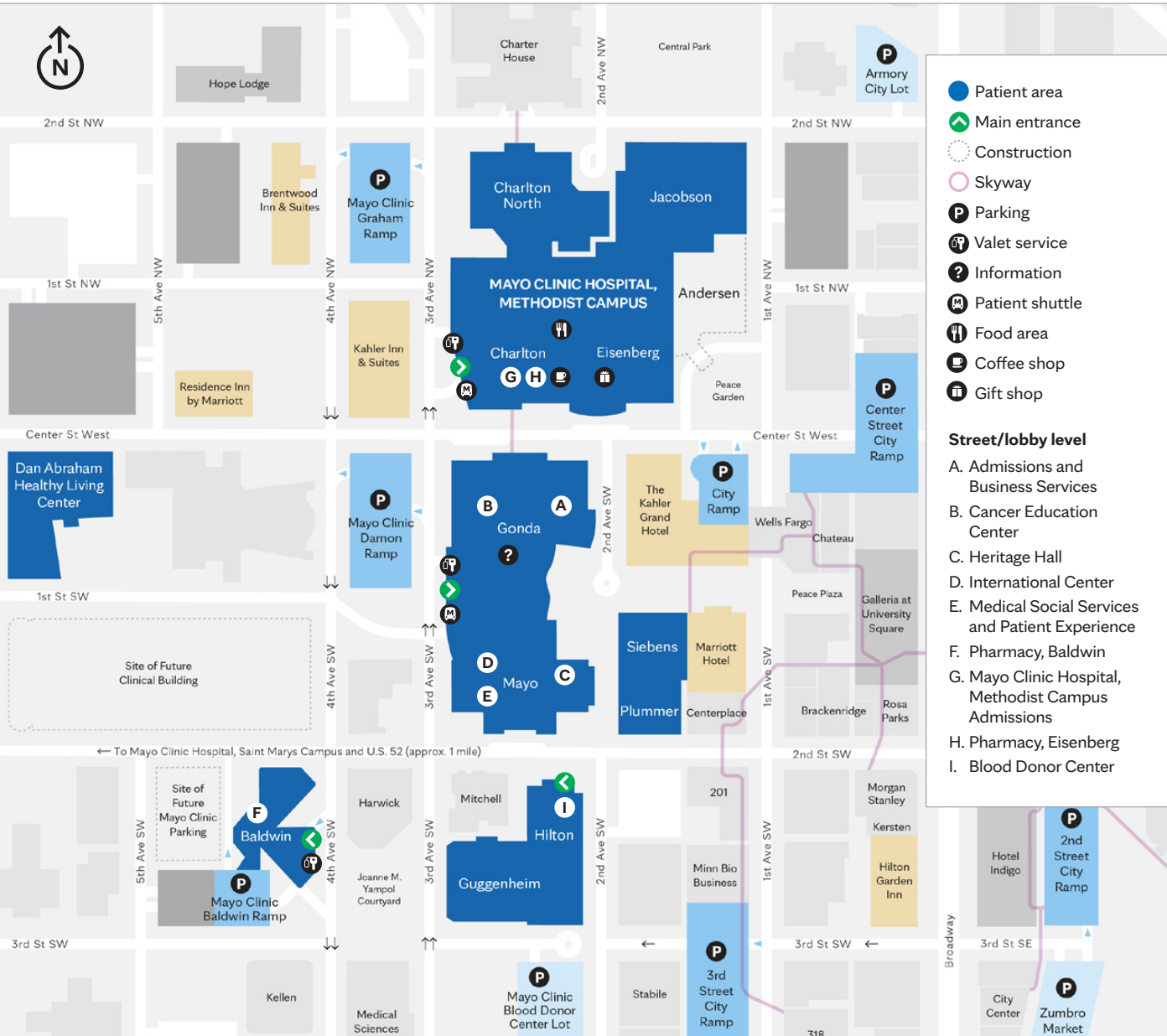

## STREET/LOBBY LEVEL



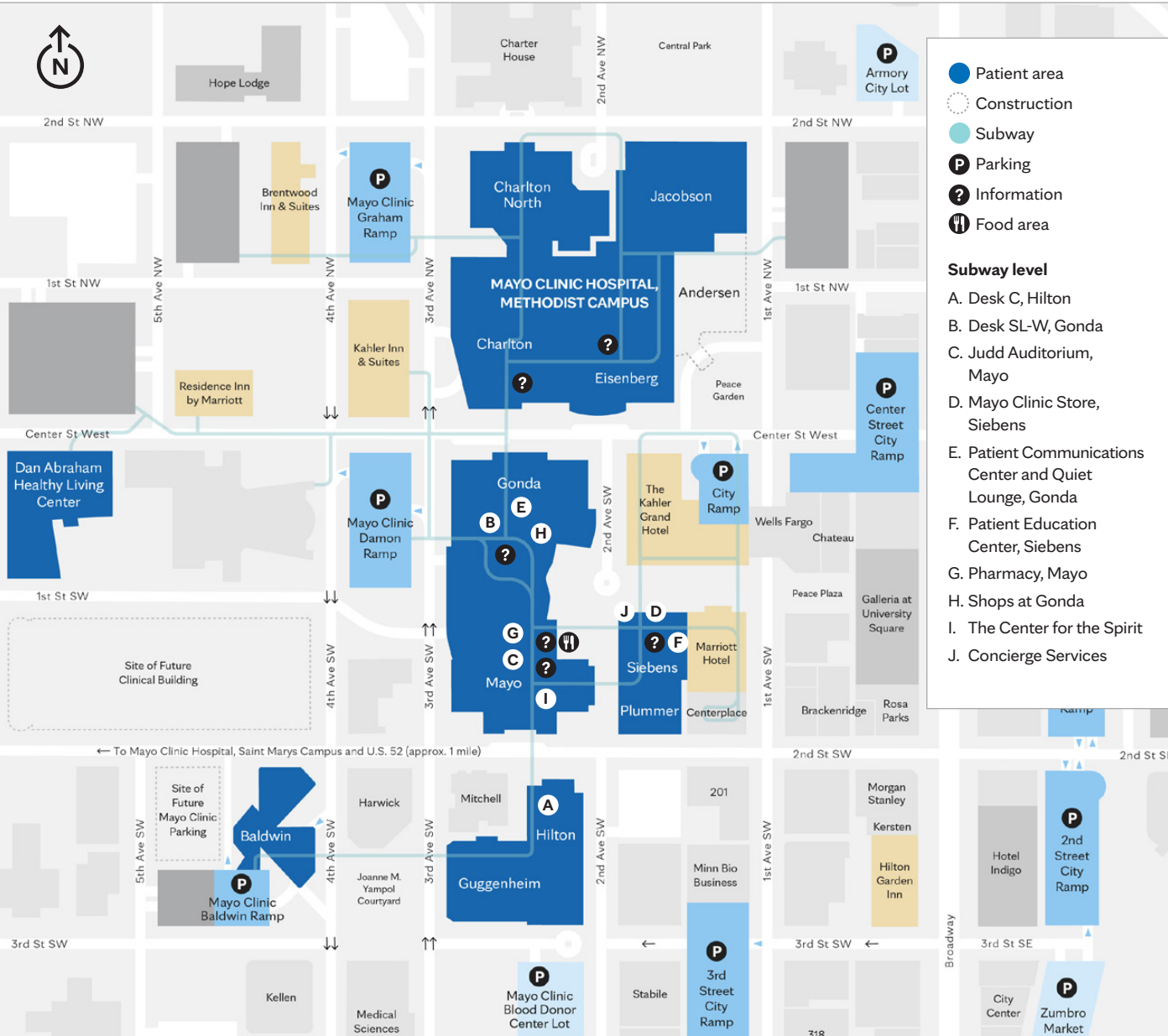

## SUBWAY LEVEL



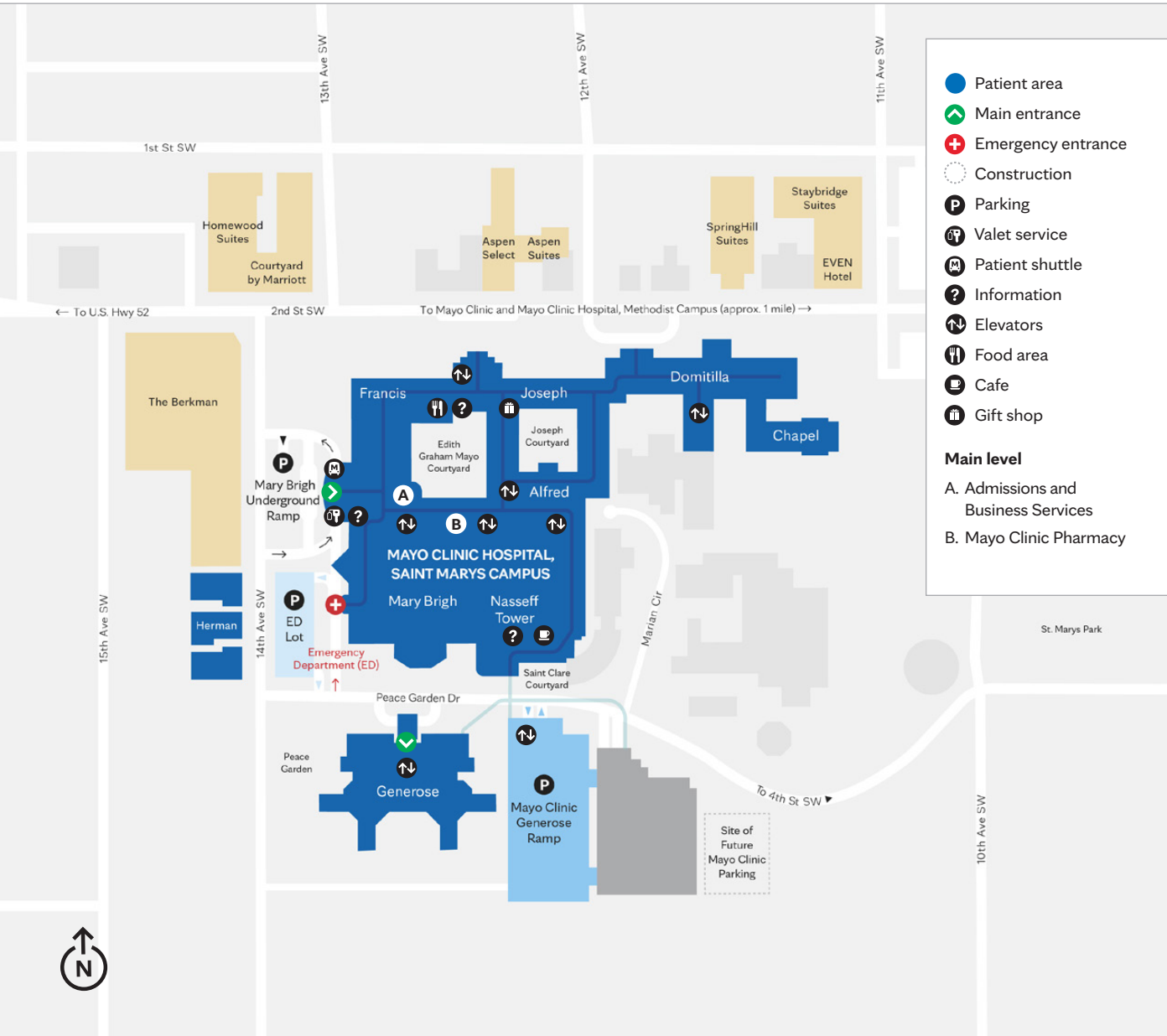
