Commuting Options for Mayo Clinic Allied Health Staff



Shuttle lots

Park your vehicle in a convenient Mayo Clinic Shuttle Lot and ride a Mayo Shuttle to the downtown or SMH campus. To ride, you must have your Mayo Clinic badge.

Five Locations

- West Lot (Lot 36) to SMH - Francis
- East Lot (Lot 35) to Downtown - Mayo South
- K-Park (Lot 38) to SMH - Generose
- North Lot (Lot 39) to SMH- Generose
- Northwest Lot (Lot 40) to Downtown Guggenheim



Commuter buses

Commuter buses run from centralized hubs in Byron, Kasson, and Stewartville, with two routes scheduled per hub each weekday morning and evening. Mayo Clinic will subsidize the cost of the commuter buses, with staff paying \$2 per ride which is billed monthly.

Reservations can be made up to two weeks in advance, with a new week of reservations opening each Monday at 10:30 a.m.

RPT park & ride

Park your vehicle in a convenient RPT Park & Ride lot and ride a RPT Park & Ride bus to the Downtown and Saint Marys campuses. To ride, you must have your Mayo Clinic badge.

Four Locations

- N. Broadway (CMX Chateau Theater)
- RCTC
- Olmsted County Fairgrounds
- 75th Street NW

Ride an RPT Park & Ride bus at least four times per week in a rolling month and receive a complimentary DAHLC monthly membership.



RPT neighborhood routes

Get picked up close to home with RPT neighborhood routes. Mayo Clinic staff ride for free, stop by the card access office to pick up your transit pass!

Passes should be used only for your commute to or from work, not for groceries or other adventures.

Ride an RPT neighborhood bus at least four times per week in a rolling month and receive a complimentary DAHLC monthly membership.



Carpool and vanpools

Set up a carpool for 3 or more Mayo Clinic staff with similar shifts who live near you, or arrange a vanpool which are subsidized rentals arranged through Commute with Enterprise. Both options include preferred onsite parking. Enterprise will help you find a vanpool to join or help you start one!

Bike to work

Four Secure Bike Room Locations

- First Street Ramp (Ramp 12)
- West Ramp (Ramp 9)
- Discovery Ramp
- East Ramp on SMC (Ramp 34)

Bike to work and park in a secure bike room 4 times a month and receive a complimentary DAHLC monthly membership.



On-campus parking

Flex parking options are available to all staff on a first-come, first-served basis. Before parking in a Mayo Clinic staff lot or ramp you must register your vehicle at javaprod.mayo.edu/VehicleRegistration/Login.html

Parking lottery

Allied health staff who work downtown or on the Saint Marys Campus can enter to win a quarterly parking space through the staff parking lottery. Entries will be weighted based on years of service.

Mayo Ramp Lottery Staff can sign up to win a parking space at either the downtown or at the Saint Marys Campus.

City Ramp Lottery: Staff can sign up to win a daily parking space in the First Street Ramp, Third Street Ramp or Ramp 6.

Friday Lottery: Staff can sign up to win a parking space in the West Employee Ramp (Ramp 9) or the East Employee Ramp (Ramp 23) on Fridays.
